Solihin Garrard Director and Principal Consultant, Makesfive Ltd

Solihin Garrard has led his own consultancy company, [Makesfive Ltd](#), for over 14 years, supporting initiatives at national, regional, sub-regional and local levels. This experience has included national programme evaluation, research, analysis & national publication of good practice; also partnership development, managing European projects & higher education assignments, building capacity in a range of fields, and supporting performance improvement and management. The areas he has principally worked in include education and training, local government, voluntary and community sector, private sector, multi-agency working, local strategic partnerships. Prior to that Solihin was a local education authority project manager for a multi-agency/multi-authority network, and before that a secondary school teacher & head of department. Most recently he set up and now project manages his own online only global art gallery.

Through Makesfive Solihin has supported many partnership and collaborative initiatives across all sectors and worked on many research and evaluation projects. He has delivered keynote speeches for senior RDA policy makers; undertaken national evaluation projects; helped develop effective collaborative working in LSPs. He has also run workshops to develop partnership skills; supported the development of national resources for the Voluntary and Community Sector; led ESF training and capacity building projects, for the voluntary, private, and public sectors. Following a review of “what works” for data sharing for LSPs with Educe Ltd, he worked in the team that evaluated the *Supporting Evidence for Local Delivery* pilots for the DCLG. Together Educe and Makesfive also supported SEEDA and AWM by auditing, reviewing and building partnership agreements between the respective RDAs and their Sub-regional Economic Partnerships. In January 2009 they supported the South East England Regional Assembly’s select committee on *SEEDA and sub-regional working*, researching and writing the background “context and issues paper” and participating in the select committee. In the spring of 2009 Solihin undertook ground breaking research into the scale of investment in adult learning within the third sector (TS) as part of the *Inquiry into the Future for Lifelong Learning (IFLL)* which reported in September 2009.

Makesfive led the *Facilitating Effective Partnerships* service within Learning and Skills Network *Solutions*. In this role Solihin has supported Further Education and Adult Learning strategic partnership developments. In March 2008 Solihin ran workshops on “*Skills for Successful Partnerships*”, delivering a powerful and innovative programme as part of the Egan agenda.

Makesfive has been on the Sustainable Communities and National Public Policy Approved Suppliers List of the IDeA since 2007, and now holds a Consultancy Framework (to 2013) covering Generic skills. In this role Solihin facilitated for 18 months *Neighbourhoods—the role of frontline councillors*, one of the IDeA’s on-line communities of practice; he has also worked with the IDeA in reviewing and building new content for its community empowerment website pages. He contributed to the debate led by Demos that led to the publication of “*The Collaborative State*” (March 2007); delivered capacity building support relating to data sharing and data protection with Zennor Consulting within the LDA Opportunities Fund. Solihin wrote a guide to “*How Your Council Works*” for NAVCA/ IDeA/ Urban Forum on behalf of the National Empowerment Partnership, published in September 2008. Solihin also facilitated strategic workshops for Susila Dharma International, helping international members plan key Goals for a new four-year work period. Solihin is an associate of Delta Partnership, a global management consultancy with a focus on building capacity in public services, including in developing countries.

Most recently Solihin set up, together with Makesfive co-director Sofiah Garrard, [Green Chair Gallery](#), an online-only art gallery, and has currently run 4 key exhibitions, with a forward programme for the rest of 2010 already in place.
